Public Use Computers

Two computers with internet are available for public use on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a time limit of 20 minutes if others are waiting. Please sign in with the Librarian prior your internet session.

Library's Policy and Procedures:

- The library can accept neither responsibility nor liability for the quality or accuracy of information retrieved through the Internet. This is the responsibility of the user. Similarly, the library can accept neither responsibility nor liability for the use of the Internet by children. Only parents and legal guardians have the right – and the responsibility – to monitor and control their own minor children's access to the Internet and to information obtained from the Internet. The selections policy which guides the library's purchase of print materials cannot be applied to information accessed through the Internet.
- Internet access is provided for informational purposes. Users are to use discretion and to refrain from the display or sending of information which may be reasonably deemed as obscene, illegal, discriminatory, defamatory, harassment, profanity, commercial, causing annoyance or inconvenience.
- Users are requested to refrain from recreational chat, games or similar services.
- Assistance from library staff in Internet use or research may be limited at certain times.
- Users are welcome to apply for their own email address at no charge using a commercial service. Users may not use the library's email address in sending or receiving email.
- Files created on this computer will not be private and may be deleted by library staff.
- It is the user's responsibility to ensure they are not violating copyright law. In most cases copyright law permits the making of a single copy for purposes of research or private study.
- Printing is available at a cost of 25¢ per sheet to help cover costs.
