How do I use wireless at the Library?

- You will need to bring your own Wi-Fi ready laptop computer to the Library. No password is required. Users should be able to detect and connect to Library Wi-Fi easily in the Library area.
- The Library cannot guarantee that this service will be available at any specific time or at any specific speed, nor can the library accept reservations for wireless access.

Library's Policy and Procedures:

All applicable rules from the Pinawa Public Library Internet Use Policy will apply. For instance, you must not use the connection for illegal purposes.

- Users are responsible for setting up their equipment and access.
- All virus and security protection is the responsibility of the user. Our Internet connection is open and unfiltered. Be aware that as wireless access is sent over radio signals, 'eavesdropping' by other users, though unlikely, is possible. Keep this in mind as you choose whether to transmit confidential data.
- The Library does not assume responsibility for any damage, theft, alterations, interference or loss of any kind to a user's equipment, software, data files or other personal property brought into or used at the library's facilities. The Library is not responsible for work or information lost due to computer or system malfunction.
- We do not have printers connected to the wireless access. Users can save their files to a removable (USB) drive and then use one of our public workstations to print.
