Chairperson's Report 2015

Nowadays almost all libraries face questions about their continued relevance in a digital, multi-media world in which people live through their phones. It is reassuring, therefore, that the Pinawa Public Library continues to benefit from the work of volunteers. The willingness of many men and women in Pinawa to give their time to this library is a testimonial to its importance as a comfortable, welcoming public space open to everyone at no charge to users. Our volunteers not only check out books and reshelve incoming books but also put protective covers on new books, help set up, operate and take down our booksale tables at town markets, assist at our annual Quiz Night fund raiser and do many other tasks. All told these volunteers are vital in making this library the successful public institution it is.

Statistically, the Pinawa Public Library is doing well. Our physical circulation has held steady for the last couple of years despite the rise in popularity of ebooks. On a per capita basis, relative to other rural libraries in Manitoba our circulation was among the best in 2015 at 12.1 vs an average of 6.5. The ebook circulation was a high 1.75 per capita vs. an average of 0.52 for Manitoban rural libraries. Our website visits were in line with other rural libraries while our program visits per capita were higher at 0.46, vs an average of 0.22.

In 2015 the library hosted 13 special events. Of particular note was our Nordic Noir month (March) with a book presentation, a session on viewing subtitled Nordic Noir TV series using region free DVD players, and a wellattended photo travelogue, In the Footsteps of the Vikings. As a key component of this program, the Librarian created a special Nordic Noir brochure, listing all Nordic Noir titles in the library, which many patrons found useful.

Finally we held our 5th annual Quiz Night in early October, which was sold out well in advance and proved to be the enjoyable, noisy evening we have now come to expect, and a financially successful one for the Library.
