1. Quiz Night Planning Meeting: The following is a record of points discussed:

- Reviewed 2016 Quiz Night financial report including expenditures and income.
- 2017 Quiz Night to be held Friday, Sept 29, 2017.
- Registration for teams will begin Sept 05, 2017. Effort will be made by the PPL board to ensure information on Quiz Night is available via Facebook, Pinawa Channel 12 and LGD office.
- Quiz night Quizmasters have been booked for the 2018 PPL Quiz Night (Friday Sept 28, 2018).
- 2017 Quiz Night team fee will be \$100.00. There will be 23 team spots available.
- Gym set up will happen the day of the event - Sept 29, 2017: Carpet, tables and chairs, bar etc. Marg will contact Merv Voth at the PSS to see what time we may begin our set up for the event. Marg will check with last year's volunteers to see if they are again willing to help with setup.
- Marg will see about ordering rolls of plastic for tablecloths from Amazon.ca.
- Marg will organize cash floats for the bar and 50/50.
- There are tickets left over from last year for the bar sales and the 50/50 draw – but more tickets may be purchased to ensure we do not run out.
- We are considering using chocolate 'medallions' as prizes instead of trophies.
- Myrna will be responsible for running the bar. Myrna has contacted Mike Berry regarding helping at the bar. She is waiting to hear back from him. If Mike is unable to help, Myrna will find an alternate volunteer.
 - Bar prices will be: bottle of wine \$20.00, glass of wine \$5.00, beer \$5.00.
- Myrna will provide snacks for bar volunteers.
- The old cooler currently in the lobby of the Community Centre is being replaced and we hope the replacement will be installed before Quiz Night as the shelves etc. on the old cooler are not reliable.
- Mike Luke will order the liquor for the event and get the liquor license. The newer version of the liquor license requires us to check off the 'social occasion permit' in order to legally run our 50/50 fund-raiser. Liquor license time will be listed as 6:30 till midnight.
- Bottled water will be picked up by Marg.
- Ice will be picked up by Myrna (15 bags).
- Coffee/tea table will be set up by Marg.
- Ann will be in charge of cash flow at the event.

- 3 markers will be required to check team answers.
- 2 sellers for the 50/50 draw will be needed.
